NTTA OPENS NEW SOUTH DALLAS COUNTY CUSTOMER SERVICE CENTER

PLANO, Texas – June 15, 2017 – The North Texas Tollway Authority (NTTA) will hold a grand opening of a new Customer Service Center to serve drivers in and near South Dallas county. The NTTA Customer Service Center is located inside the Texas Department of Public Safety Driver License Center at 39025 LBJ Service Road, Dallas, 75232 – located near the northwest corner of the Interstate 20 and I-35E interchange.



Grand opening festivities take place this Friday from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Dallas Cowboys legend Drew Pearson will be on hand to sign autographs from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m.

The full-service location will provide more convenient access to drivers who live in or near South Dallas county. Customers can open credit and cashbacked TollTag accounts, replenish TollTag accounts and make ZipCash invoice payments at the new location. ZipCash customers who become TollTag members receive the TollTag discount.

The South Dallas county Customer Service Center operating hours will be from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Tuesdays and from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. all other weekdays. The DPS center and TollTag store are closed on weekends.

The <u>nine-member board</u> is comprised of Chairman Kenneth Barr; Vice Chairman Bill Moore; and Directors William D. Elliott, Mojy Haddad, John Mahalik, Michael Nowels, George "Tex" Quesada, Carl O. Sherman and Jane Willard.

NTTA serves Collin, Dallas, Denton, Tarrant and Johnson counties and owns and operates the Dallas North Tollway, President George Bush Turnpike, Sam Rayburn Tollway, Addison Airport Toll Tunnel, Lewisville Lake Toll Bridge, Mountain Creek Lake Bridge and Chisholm Trail Parkway. NTTA raises capital for construction projects through the

issuance of turnpike revenue bonds. NTTA toll projects are not a part of the state highway system and receive no direct tax funding. Tolls are collected to repay debt and to operate and maintain the roadways.
