# Dallas North Tollway Phase 4

SPRING 2023

The Dallas North Tollway (DNT) Phase 4 project will extend the tollway 13.7 miles north of US 380. When this extension is complete, it will provide a direct link between downtown Dallas and the growing communities in Collin and Denton counties. Opening date: To be determined.

#### **RECENT PROGRESS**

- Phase 4A: Crews completed placing overhead signs and permanent striping for the DNT extension bridge. North- and southbound lanes have opened to traffic.
- Phase 4A: Design of the DNT 4A mainlane extension from US 380 to FM 428 continues.

### WHAT'S NEXT?

- Phase 4A: Crews will continue landscaping and finishing work between PGA Pkwy. in Frisco and First St. in Prosper.
- Phase 4A: Design of the DNT 4A mainlanes continues.
- Coordination with stakeholders and partners continues.
