The toll rate will increase about one penny per mile on average – from 20 to 21 cents, effective July 1.

On average, TollTag customers can expect to spend about \$5.60 more per month – that's close to the cost of a medium latté. Drivers who choose not to have a TollTag account and use the ZipCash (pay-by-mail) payment method will now pay double the TollTag rate to help offset the cost to collect those tolls.

Scheduled rate increases are part of NTTA's commitment to repay \$9.5 billion borrowed to build the toll roads you use now. It also funds future projects, such as the current expansion of the Dallas North Tollway. NTTA does not receive tax dollars to build, operate and maintain its roads.

As a TollTag customer, you will always receive the lowest toll rate for safe, smooth, convenient travel on NTTA roads. That's not all. Through our <u>TollPerks Rewards</u> program, you can score free rewards and discounts for using your TollTag on NTTA roads. Interested in getting away for a bit?
