

Dallas North Tollway Phase 4

FALL 2023

The Dallas North Tollway (DNT) Phase 4 project will extend the tollway 13.7 miles north of US 380. When this extension is complete, it will provide a direct link between downtown Dallas and the growing communities in Collin and Denton counties.

RECENT PROGRESS

- Finishing work and landscaping are complete on the DNT Extension over US 380 into Prosper and Celina.
- Phase 4A: Design of the DNT 4A mainlane extension from US 380 to FM 428 is complete.
- Phase 4A: Local outreach ahead of construction has begun.

WHAT'S NEXT?

- Phase 4A: Contracts for construction management, construction and material testing will be awarded in 2024.
- Phase 4A: Construction of the mainlanes from the DNT extension over US 380 to FM 428 will begin in Spring 2024.
- Phase 4A: Coordination with stakeholders and partners continues.
